



In the Matter of part of the Village Green,
Lustleigh

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 97 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 120 and 924 made by A J Allin and W H Cullin and noted in the Register on 14 September 1970 and 8 July 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 2 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P G Hewison (a member of Lustleigh Parish Council). Mr Lustleigh produced a Conveyance by which all the land comprised in the register unit had been conveyed to a trustee upon trusts for the benefit of the inhabitants of the village.

Objection No. 120 was withdrawn and no one appeared in support of Objection No. 924.

For these reasons I confirm the registration
