

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

## In the Matter of Shore Bottom, Stockland, Devon (No.3).

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL 5 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.662 made by Mr F.J. Shipp and noted in the Register on 27th November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 23rd October 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr P.A.J. Browne, solicitor, on behalf of the Devon County Council, the applicant for the registration. Mr Shipp did not appear and was not represented.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Shore Bottom</u>, <u>Stockland (No.1)</u> (1974) No.209/D/11, I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit. It therefore follows that I cannot confirm the registration the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
