



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 9/D/18

In the Matter of The Village Green, Woodbury, Devon (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.VG.40 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Devon County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 22nd October 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr Graham Neville, of counsel, on behalf of Mr A.W. Miles, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.2, and by Mr Harold Burnett, of counsel, on behalf of the Woodbury Parish Council, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.1.

For the reasons stated in my decision in <u>In the Matter of the Village Green, Woodbury (No.1)</u>, (1974) No.9/D/17 I am satisfied that <u>Ir Miles</u> is the owner of the land comprised in the registration the subject of this dispute. I therefore confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which actice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
