

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 209/D/169

In the Matter of The Village Green and The Courtledge, Loddiswell, Devon

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 81 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 899 made by Mrs E Walke and noted in the Register on 1 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dartmouth on 21 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A J Goddard, Solicitor, on behalf of the Loddiswell Parish Council, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objector, but solicitors acting for her daughter and successor in title stated in a letter dated 24 April 1980, addressed to the Clerk to the County Council, that the Objection would not be pursued.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
