



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 209/D/207-208

In the Matter of Tracts of land known as Farway  
Common, Broad Down and Strip Common

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and at Entries 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 214 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 307 made by the Trustees of the Coombe Estate and noted in the Register on 18 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 2 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Miles of Messrs Dunning and Co, Honiton for Messrs A Banks and Sons, the applicants and Mr J S Neason of Messrs S Michelmore Hughes, Wilbraham of Exeter for the Trustees.

Both parties informed me that the application in the Rights Section was withdrawn so far as it related to the land shown marked B and hatched red on the register plan and that the Objections in the Land and Rights Sections were withdrawn so far as they related to the land shown marked A and hatched red on the said plan.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations, but only in respect of the land shown marked A and hatched red on the register plan.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
