



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Trinity Hill Common,  
Axminster, Devon (No.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.186 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.15 made by the former Axminster Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 27th February 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 23rd October 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr T.J. Elliott, solicitor, on behalf of the East Devon District Council.

The registration was made in consequence of an application made by Mr A.J. Hooper for the registration of a right to graze 10 bullocks over the whole of the land in question. At the hearing Mr Elliott informed me that the East Devon District Council, as successors to the Axminster Rural District Council, no longer wished to pursue its objection, since Mr Hooper had produced documentary evidence of his right to common of pasture.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
