

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 209/D/385

In the Matter of Wick Green.Luprit. Devon (NO.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 12 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.43 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 13 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 11 April 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr J Sage, one of the applicants for the registration, and Mr Salter, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

The conflict is caused by the fact that both registrations relate to the same dominant tenement, Mr Salter having applied as tenant in respect of 3 sheep, while Mr Sage and Mr T E Thorne applied as trustees in respect of 5 sheep.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
