



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 140 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 1050 made by Mr H J R Bankes and Objection No. 1196 made by Mr D C D Ryder and both noted in the Register on 24 August 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
