



In the Matter of Bourne Bottom,
Poole, Dorset

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 53/2 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 53 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 1 made by the Talbot Village Trustees and noted in the Register on 20 May 1969 and several hundred objections made by local residents and all noted in the Register on 11 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on November 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr Streatfield, the applicant for a registration noted under section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, and by Mr R M Wickenden, the Deputy Town Clerk of Poole. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr P B Dingle, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Streatfield informed me that he did not wish to support the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state the case for the decision of the High Court.
