



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/94

In the Matter of Bowood Common,
Hetherbury, Dorset (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 189/1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 189 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 992 made by Mr C B Gadsby and noted in the Register on 8 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 22 April 1976. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

In the absence of any evidence, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
