

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/271

In the Matter of Bow's Hill. Mether Ceine, Dorset

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Futry No. 220/1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 220 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 138 made by Mr C E H Gallia and noted in the Register on 25 June 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weymouth on 21 Movember 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P Clayden of the Ramblers Association and Mr D Batten, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr Gallia.

The registration was made on the application of Firs R Colyer for the Ramblers Association. The ground of the objection is that the land was not common land at the date of registration. There are no rights of common registered.

Mr Clayden informed me that the Association and Mrs Colyer were not pursuing the application or resisting the objection. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
