



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 210/D/234-235

In the Matter of Fairfield, Iwerne
Courtney or Shraton, Dorset

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 43 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG.43 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 129 made by Mr W H Gibson Fleming and Objection No. 1236 made by the former Dorset County Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 28 November 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr L W Heeler, Assistant Secretary of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration, Mr H E F Lock, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Gibson Fleming, and Mr D S Harper, solicitor, on behalf of the Dorset County Council.

Mr Heeler informed me that he did not wish to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
