



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 10/D/43-44

In the Matter of Kingdown, Pamphill, Dorset(No. 2)DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.70 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 344 made by Mr H J R Bankes and by Objection No. 455 made by the Clerk of the County Council and both noted in the Register on 29th March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 6th January 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr. B J Pickering, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr. C E D Gibson, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr Gerard Ryan, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr Bankes. Before the hearing the Dorset County Council informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners that it wished to "withdraw" Objection No. 455.

Mr. Ryan informed me that the parties were agreed that I should be asked to refuse to confirm the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
