

COLLIGIA REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Now. 210/0/9/258

In the Matter of Land at Filford, Netherbury, Dorset.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 27 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 28 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 200 made by Nr J B Hill, Objection No. 201 made by Nr R T Brown, and Objection No. 438 made by the Clerk of the former Dorset County Council, and all noted in the Register on 27 January 1971

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 22 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Ir Brown. No other person entitled to be heard attended or was represented.

There being no evidence in support of the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroncous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
