



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 210/D/240-242

In the Matter of Okeford Common,
Okeford Fitzpaire, Dorset

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 289/1 in the land section of Register Unit No: CL 289 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. 1095 and 1215 both made by Mr A J M Trowbridge and Objection No. 1214 made by Mr J A Woodhouse and all noted in the Register on 5 March 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 28 November 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr L W Heeler, the Assistant Secretary of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Heeler informed me that he did not wish to support the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
