



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 14/D/80 and 81

In the Matter of Parts of Chewton  
Common, Christchurch B.C.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No.2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.269 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. OB342 and OB344 made by the Trustees of the Meyrick 1968 combined Trust and both noted in the Register on 6 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 10th July 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr.D.Harper senior assistant County Solicitor for the County of Dorset Mr. P.Samuel on behalf of Christchurch B.C.Mr. D.Milligan agent for the Meyrick Trust and Mr. A.Lovell in person.

The circumstances in this case are indistinguishable from these in the References Nos. 14/D/47 and 48 in respect of which my decision is dated, 7<sup>th</sup> August 1975.

For the reasons given in that decision I refuse to confirm the Entry at No. 1 in the Land Section and the Entry at No. 2 in the Rights Section

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
