



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of South Down,
Ibberton, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 178 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.178 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 194 made by Messrs Senior and Godwin, agents to the Trustees of Mr A E Browning, deceased, and noted in the Register on 6th December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 6th January 1976. The hearing was attended by Mrs R Colyer, who applied for the registration on behalf of the Ramblers' Association, and by Mr C George, of counsel, on behalf of the Prudential Assurance Co Ltd, the successors in title of Mr Browning's Executors.

Mrs Colyer informed me that the Ramblers' Association did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
