In the Matter of Stoborough Heath, Arms and East Holme, Dorset.

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 87 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 87 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 3 made by Mr D E Scott and noted in the Register on 14 October 1969, and Objection No. 444 made by the Trustees of the Holme Estate, Objection No. 456 made by the Clerk of the former Dorset County Council, and Objection No. 863 made by Pike Bros, Fayle & Co Ltd and all noted in the Register on 11 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on The hearing was attended by Mr N Cake, the Chairman of the 22 April 1982. Commons Sub-Committee of the Arme Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, Mr L Holly, of the Dorset County Council Solicitor's Department, and Mr P H Chesterfield, the Area Estate Surveyor of Land and Properties ECC Ltd, the successors in title of Pike Bros, Fayle & Co Ltd. There was no appearance on behalf of the Ramblers' Association, whose application was noted under section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965.

Hir Cake informed me that the Parish Council did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
