



In the Matter of the piece of land called Recreation Allotment and Stockford Common containing 1.52 acres or thereabouts in the parish of East Stoke, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 358 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 358 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 29 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 29 in the Register of Town and Village Greens maintained by the Council.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that every person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest or part of the interest, of any other person has consented in writing to proposed terms.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
