



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 261 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 261 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1138 made by Morden Estates Company and noted in the Register on 9 February 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Poole on 8 July 1980. The hearing was attended by the Objector, the County Council and East Stoke Parish Council. The Applicant had written to the Commissioner withdrawing the application and the parties present consented to this.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
