COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of the tract of about 16.5 acres called Woolbury Common in the parish of Bere Regis, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 65 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 65 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 9 made by Morden Estates Company and noted in the Register on 16 October 1969 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 60 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 60 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
