

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 153 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 153 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by three Objections (1) No. 149 made by D E Scott (2) No. 911 made by P H Chesterfield (3) No. 949 made by J Baggs, all noted in the Register on 2 November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Poole on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Holly, of the Registration Authority. The Objections relate to two sections of the land in question, these two sections being shown on the plans attached to the Objections. The registration as common land was made in consequence of the application by Mr K S Ford to register Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section. It has been agreed by the parties that the registrations be cancelled in regard to the two sections, and accordingly I confirm the registration with the modification that the two sections be excluded from the land.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
