

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965 .

In the Matter of West Ward Common, Charminster, Dorset (No. 1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 142 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 270 made by the Hon Peter Pleydell Bouverie, Mr J K Lowther and Mr M P Wyndham and Objection No. 280 made by the Trustees of the late Mr G A Budden and both noted in the Register on 15 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 3 August 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr H E F Lock, solicitor, on behalf of Mr R H Childs and Mrs M K Childs and Mrs E H Hawkins, in consequence of whose application for a registration in the Rights Section of the Register Unit this registration was made, and by Miss R M Cullen, of Counsel, on behalf of the Objector:

I was informed that it was not desired to support the registration, so it only remain for me to refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
