



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of North Gate Fell,

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entries No. 1, 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 59 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and are occasioned by Objections No. 64, No. 65 and No. 66 made by J S Stephenson and Others and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Darlington on 23 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr L Pattinson, Solicitor appearing on behalf of the applicants for registration. Solicitors for the Objectors had written withdrawing the Objections and accordingly I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
