

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 211/D/155

In the Matter of The Commons, Hutton Henry, Co. Durham (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 64 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 114 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 1 July 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

There is no Objection relating to either of the registrations, which will therefore have to be confirmed either in the Register of Common Land or in the Register of Town or Village Greens. There being no evidence in support of the conflicting registration, I confirm both the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
