

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 211/D/152

In the Matter of The Green, Dalton-le-Dale, Co. Durham (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 86 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 1 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J J Holmes, an officer of the National Coal Board, the owner of East Farm, Dalton-le-Dale, the former tenant of which, Mr A H Shield, applied for the registration.

Mr Holmes informed me that the National Coal Board did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
