

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 211/D/116

In the Matter of The Old Quarry lying adjacent to Castle Hill Plantation, Wolsingham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 79 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 52 made by Mr T W Love and noted in the Register on 6 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Darlington on 22 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr T Turnbull, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Mr T W Love. The registration was made on the application of Mr D Wilson, who by letter dated 24 June 1980 had written accepting the Objection, and I shall accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
