



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 211/D/126

In the Matter of The Village Green,
Sunderland Bridge, Co. Durham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 31 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 3 made by Capt. G M Salvin and noted in the Register on 28 April 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 2 July 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J B Clinton, Solicitor, on behalf of the Sunderland Bridge Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and I gave leave for the Objector to be represented by his land agent, Mr P Vaux.

Mr Clinton informed me that he was instructed to agree to the exclusion from the Register Unit of the land the subject of the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the exclusion of the land shown coloured green on the plan attached to the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
