



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 37/D/64

In the Matter of Launces Common, Wivelsfield,  
East Sussex (No.1)

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DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.94 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 44 made by Mr and Mrs A E Shrosbree and noted in the Register on 16 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lewes on 16 November 1973. The hearing was attended by Mr Shrosbree and by Mr W E K Lincoln, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of the Register Unit.

The Objection relates only to the inclusion in the Register <sup>Unit</sup> of a house known as Lunces Ridge and its curtilage in the occupation and ownership of the objectors.

There being no appearance to support the inclusion of the Objectors' property in the Register Unit, I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
