



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Piltdown Common, Maresfield
and Fletching, and Grisling Common, Fletching,
East Sussex (No.3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 30 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.24 made by the Trustees of Piltdown Golf Club and noted in the Register on 30th July 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that every person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest or part of the interest, of any other person has consented in writing to the proposed terms.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the land hatched red on the Register Map.
