



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.37/D/13

In the Matter of The Tye,
Alfriston, East Sussex.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.VG 18 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.1 made by the Alfriston Parish Council and noted in the Register on 12th February 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lewes on 20th November 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr B.D.Cooper, solicitor, on behalf of the Parish Council.

This matter came before Mr Commissioner Baden Fuller on 8th March 1973, when Mr Cooper stated that Mr G.Ingram, the applicant for the registration, had died. There being no appearance on behalf of Mr Ingram's personal representative, the matter was then adjourned.

Before me Mr Cooper produced a statement signed by Mrs Joyce Ingram, one of Mr Ingram's executors, that it was not the intention of the personal representatives to proceed with the claim.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
