



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 37/D/10

In the Matter of Town Croft, Hartfield,
Uckfield R.D., East Sussex

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG.21 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 62 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 30 October 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that following the concession of Objection No.62 against the inclusion in the registration as a town or village green of a public footpath and a bridleway as part of the above Register Unit, the Commons Commissioner do modify and confirm as modified the registration of the above mentioned land accordingly. The grounds of the said Objection were "that the part of the land shown coloured blue on the attached plan is public highway and was not village green at the date of registration". The said attached plan showed coloured blue two narrow strips of land adjoining the north side and the south side of the land comprised in this Register Unit.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:- The two narrow strips of land shown coloured blue on the plan attached to the said objection are to be removed from the Register.
