



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Four pieces of land -

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. VG 32 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 482 made by Writtle Parish Council and noted in the Register on 21 February 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chelmsford on 18 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A Sayles, of the firm of Hilliard and Ward, Solicitors, appearing on behalf of Writtle Parish Council.

The registration in the Ownership Section was made on the application of Lord Petre, who in a letter dated 23 January 1981 stated that he withdrew his claim. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
