



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 212/D/274

In the Matter of Land at Passingford Bridge, Stapleford
Tawney, Essex

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.447 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Essex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 432 made by the former Essex County Council and noted in the Register on 28 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chelmsford on 9 March 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr R J Carpenter, the Hon. Footpaths Secretary of the Chelmsford branch of the Ramblers Association, the applicants for the registration, who asked me to refuse to confirm the registration which I accordingly do.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
