



In the Matter of The Tye and the Land on each Side of the Road from East Hanningfield Village to the Rettendon Parish Boundary, East Hanningfield, Essex.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 422 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Essex County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos 103 and 152 made by Truman Hanbury Buxton and Co Ltd and noted in the Register on 21 and 28 September 1970 respectively and the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No V.G.50 in the Register of Town or Village Green maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chelmsford on 19 January 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr E A Peel, solicitor, on behalf of the East Hanningfield Parish Council, the applicants for both the registration and the conflicting registration, and by Mr K H Moffat of the Objector's legal department.

Mr Peel stated that he was instructed not to pursue this registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
