

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 212/U/285

In the Matter of Village Green, the High Street, Roydon, Epping Forest D

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land described above being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.120 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Essex County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question or to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Chelmsford on 21 July 1983.

At the hearing Mr M F Berendt, Vice Chairman of Royden Parish Council appeared on behalf. He told me that the Parish Council looks after the Green but has no evidence &n which to base a claim. There was no other appearance.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Essex County Council, as registration authority, to register Royden Parish Council as the owner of the land under Section  $\varepsilon$  (3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of <u>law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
