



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.213/D/93-94

In the Matter of Common Wood Woolaston
Forest of Dean D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.221 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 179 made by the Trustees of the Woolaston Pools Land Charity and L R Duirs and noted in the Register on 2 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 19 October 1978. The hearing was not attended by any person. As long ago as 20 December 1973 the registration authority notified the office of the Commons Commissioners that the Parish Council which made the registration in the Land Section and the only applicants for rights, Lt. Col. and Mrs Phelps had agreed to withdraw their applications. This no doubt accounts for their non attendance at the hearing.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
