



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 213/D/17, 18 & 19

In the Matter of Mill Stream Bank
South Cerney, Cotswold District

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries No.1 in the Land Section and No.1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.VG.138 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos.241 and 180 both made by R.J.Webb and both noted in the Register on 18th November 1971 and by Objection No.181 made by W.J.L.Timms and noted in the Register on 18th November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 18th February 1976.

The hearing was attended by Mr R J Webb in person. The South Cerney Trust which registered the land as a village green did not attend to support that Registration. In these circumstances I must refuse to confirm the Entry at No.1 in the Land Section and I must also refuse to confirm the Entry at No.1 in the Ownership Section, though I should mention that Mr & Mrs Royle had prior to the hearing notified Mr.Webb that they were withdrawing their claim to ownership.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
