



In the Matter of Sawpit, Apperley, Deerhurst,
Gloucestershire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 211 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. Ob 432 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council as Highway Authority and noted in the Register on 29 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cheltenham on 1 November 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr H B Van der Gucht, a member of the Deerhurst Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr G D Limbrick, Senior Legal Executive of the Gloucestershire County Council.

The Objection relates to only a part of the land comprised in the Register Unit, but the Parish Council now agrees that not only was that part of the land not common land at the date of registration, but that the remainder of the land comprised in the Register Unit was not common land.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
