



In the Matter of Selsley Common, King's Stanley,
Gloucestershire (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 24 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 2 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Gloucestershire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. Ob.36 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council as highway authority and Objection No. Ob. 58 made by the former Stroud Rural District Council, and both noted in the Register on 5 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 10 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr A C Parker, legal executive of the Stroud Rural District Council and Mr C L Major, solicitor, on behalf of the King's Stanley Graziers Association.

Objection No. Ob. 86 related to only part of the land comprised in the Register Unit and has been met by the exclusion of the metalled carriageway of Route No. B.4066, Objection No. Ob. 58 relates only to the registrations at Entry No. 15 applied for by Mr W P Holbrow. There was no appearance in support of this registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration at Entry Nos 1 to 14 and 16 to 24, and I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 15.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
