In the Matter of The Green, Twyning, Gloucestershire

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 8 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. VG 148 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. Ob. 589 made by Mr B C Ball and Objections Nos Ob 784 to Ob 790 made by Mr V R Halling and Mr T S Warner, and all noted in the Register on 25 July 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cheltenham on 25 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Miss Sheila Cameron, of Counsel, on behalf of the applicants for the registrations and Mr Ball and by Mr R F W Ungoed-Thomas, of counsel, on behalf of Mr Halling and Mr Warner.

Miss Cameron was able to appear for the applicants and Mr Ball (the stable one of the applicants) because she was instructed not to pursue Mr Ball's Objection.

Miss Cameron and Mr Ungoed-Thomas informed me that it had been agreed that the registrations should be confirmed with modifications. These agreed modifications were submitted to me in writing after the hearing.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations with the agreed modifications, which will be incorporated in the notice of the final disposal of the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
