



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.213/D/28

In the Matter of The Green, Wormington,  
Dumbleton, Tewkesbury D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.110 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 427 made by Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 20th November 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 17th February 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr. Limbrick on behalf of the Gloucestershire County Council.

Mr. Limbrick claimed the land identified on the plan annexed to objection No. 427 as highway land on behalf of the Gloucestershire County Council.

There is noted on the Register an application to register as common land made by L S Ward land comprising that comprised in the original application, but larger in area. The said L S Ward concedes the objection No.427.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modifications:-  
The land comprised in the Entry No. 1 in the Land Section shall comprise the land edged red and green on the plan annexed to this decision but shall exclude the land identified on the plan annexed to objection No. 427.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
