

In the Matter of The Quay, Twyning, Gloucestershire (No 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL 321 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No Ob 582 made by Mr B C Ball and noted in the Register on 8 January 1978.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cheltenham on 28 March 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr Martin Roth, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr Ball, who was also the applicant for the registration.

The particulars in col. 4 of the registration are "The registration at entry No 9 of the Register Unit No CL 46 includes the rights of common claimed over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit." When I heard disputes concerning the registrations in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 46 Mr Roth informed me that he was instructed not to support Entry No 9 in that section.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
