



In the Matter of Upham Meadow and Summer Leasow,
Twynning, Gloucestershire (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 1 to 12 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 323 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and are occasioned by conflicts between the registration at Entry No. 11 and the other registrations.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cheltenham on 25 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Miss Sheila Cameron, of counsel, on behalf of the applicants for all the registrations. This she was able to do because the conflicts had been resolved by agreement.

The land comprised in the Register Unit consists of two areas, the one to the east being known as Upham Meadow and the one to the west as Summer Leasow. The registration at Entry No. 11 is of the whole of the land comprised in the Register Unit with the exception of a small area comprised in one of the other Register entries. The other registrations are of a number of strips in Upham Meadow alone. Miss Cameron informed me that Mr B C Ball, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 11, no longer claimed to be the owner of any of the land in Upham Meadow.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration at Entry No. 11 with the following modification, namely, the substitution of the words "Summer Leasow" for the words in column 4.

Miss Cameron also informed me that there were errors in the registrations at Entry Nos 7 and 10. In order to correct these errors, I confirm these registrations with the following modifications, namely, the substitution of "888" for "842" in column 4 of Entry No. 7 and the deletion of "711" and the insertion of "713" after "712" in column 4 of Entry No. 10.

I confirm the remaining registrations without modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
