



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.59/U/3

In the Matter of Feltham Green,
Hounslow, Greater London

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Feltham Green, Hounslow, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.V.G.18 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Greater London Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Watergate House, WC2E 6LB on 10th May 1973.

At the hearing Mr. William Innes, solicitor, appeared for the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow. Feltham Common is mentioned in the enclosure award for the parish of Feltham, dated 24th September 1802, made under the Act 41 Geo.III c.cxlvi, but the extract from that document which Mr. Innes produced does not throw any light on the question of its ownership.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Greater London Council, as registration authority, to register the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow as the owner of the land under section 3(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
