



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 259/D/6-8

In the Matter of Woodside Green,
Croydon, Greater London (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL. 135 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Greater London Council and ~~was~~ occasioned by Objection No. 59 made by the Council of the London Borough of Croydon and noted in the Register on 16th December 1971 and the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. 58 and at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG. 68, in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Watergate House, London WC2 on 2nd March 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr B E Garfath, the applicant for the registration, by Mr D W J Patience, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector, and by Mr P Claydon, the General Secretary of the Woodside Green Preservation Society, the applicant for the conflicting registration in Register Unit No. VG. 68. I also heard Mr Clayden on behalf of Miss O de Reding, the applicant for the conflicting registration in Register Unit No. VG. 58.

Mr Garfath stated that he could not support the registration, so I proceeded to hear the disputes regarding the conflicting registrations.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
