

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Crow/ Knowl, Crompton,

Oldham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 259 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Greater Manchester County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 115 made by Mr F Buckley and noted in the Register on 4 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Salford on 3 April 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr M G M Brogden, Solicitor, of the Registration Authority. No one else appeared, but the Ramblers Association, the applicant for registration, had written to confirm its agreement to the cancellation of the registration. In these circumstances I shall refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from that date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
