



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 273/U/41

In the Matter of Broadstreet Common, Peterstone,
Wentlooge, Gwent

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.35 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gwent County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Cwmbran on 9 November 1988.

At the hearing the Wentlooge Community Council was represented by Mrs D Prosser (chairman) and Mrs C Moore (clerk) and Mrs J Clarke represented the Registration Authority. No one at the hearing claimed to be owner of the land.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
