

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/D/222

In the Matter of Cefn Rhudd, Llanuwehllyn, Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 5 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 126 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gwynedd County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 367 made by the Trustees of the Morris Vaughan Charity and noted in the Register on 24 February 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 9 March 1982. At the hearing Mr W H Edwards, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the successor to the applicants for registration at Entry No. 5, and Mr D R Jones, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the Objectors. The Objection is as to the number of animals referred to in the Entry (a right to graze 200 sheep over part of the Unit land). Agreement has been reached between the parties to the effect that the right shall be modified to a right to graze 155 sheep over the whole of the Unit land. Accordingly I confirm the registration with this modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
