

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/D/126 & 127

In the Matter of Ffridd Fawr, Llandegal Arfon D.

DECISION

This digpute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entrys 1 to 5 inclusive in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.107 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 31 made by Lady Douglas Pennant and noted in the Register on 7 May 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Caernarfon on 16 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Gareth Edwards counsel instructed by Messrs. Carter Vincent and Co., on behalf of Lady Douglas Pennant.

Mr Emgyr Jones the applicant for rights under Entry No. 2 is a tenant of his farm Cilgeraint from the Penrhyn Estate which owns the land in question and there can therefore be no rights appurtenant to that farm and I refuse to confirm Entry No. 2.

Mr Gareth Edwards accepted that I should confirm Entry No. 1 and that I should confirm Entrys 3.4. and 5 modified as follows:-

Entry No.4 The grazing rights to be limited to 2 cows Entry No.5 The grazing rights to be limited to 2 cows Entry No.5 The grazing rights to be limited to 2 cows

I confirm the Entry in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
